Many more people now lived in **towns** and worked in **factories**.

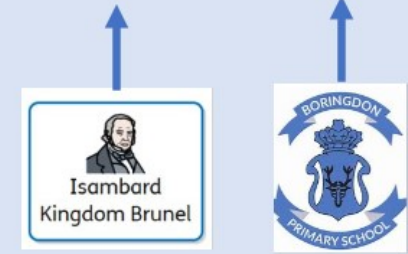
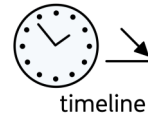


Machines were powered by **steam** and ran on **coal**.

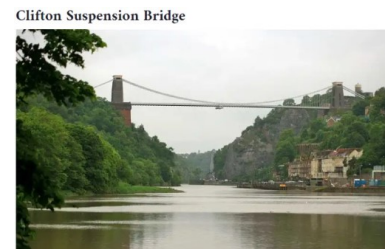
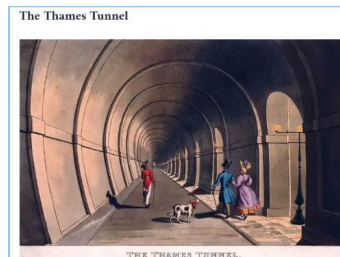
Timeline



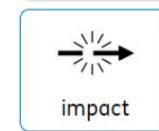
Isambard kingdom Brunel was an engineer.



He designed some of the most famous bridges, tunnels, railways and boats in the world, many of which are still around today.



Brunel's designs changed the lives of many people.



Brunel built the Royal Albert Bridge as a train link between Cornwall and the rest of the United Kingdom meaning that goods could easily be transported.



Brunel designed the SS Great Britain which was the first ocean-going, iron propeller cruise ship. It took both goods and passengers between Britain and America.
