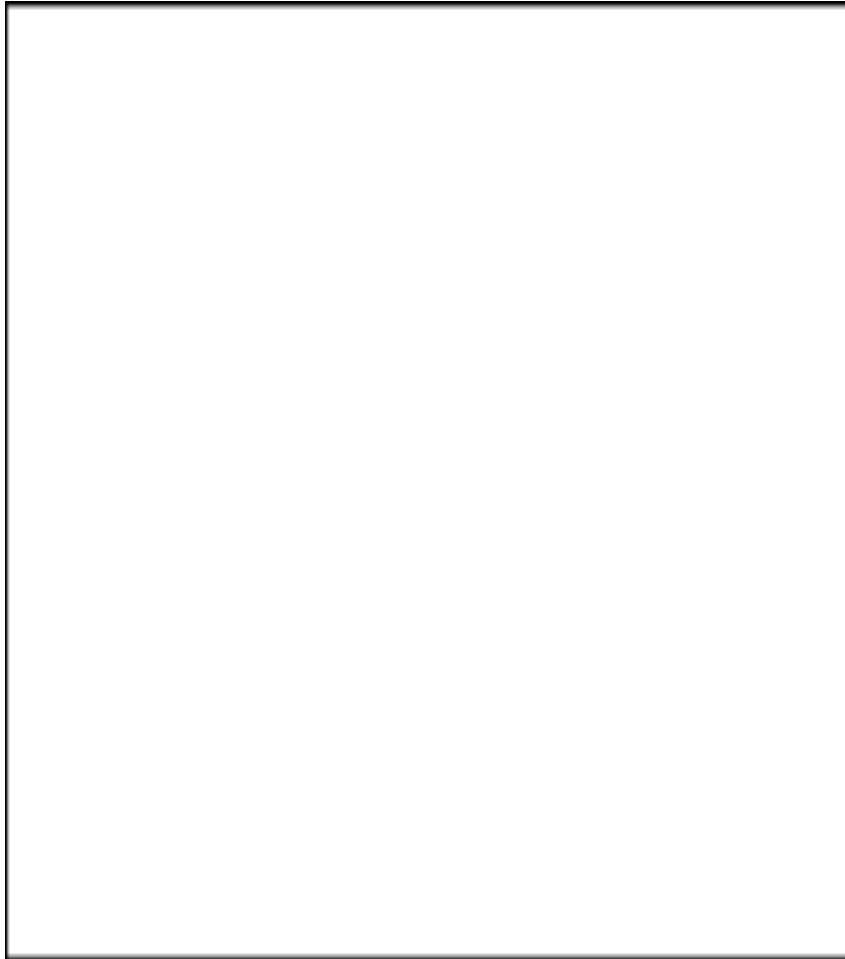




## Passport into 1ST

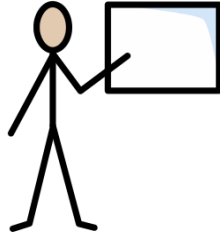
Our Head Teacher is Mr Stace.

I will enter through the outside door. This will also be where I leave for break time and at the end of the day.



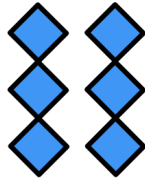
My grown ups will bring me to this playground in the mornings and wait for me there at the end of the day.

at home and do homework.

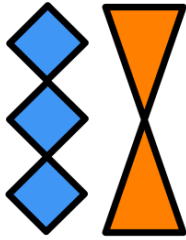
I will still get house points and stickers.

on a Wednesday.

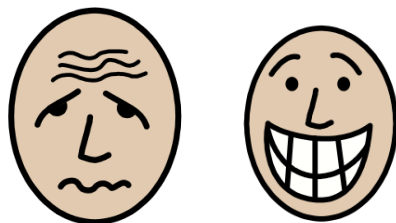
I might have different people to

Everyone feels nervous and maybe excited when they are starting something new.



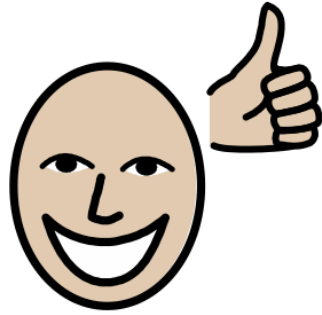
It is ok to ask questions.
