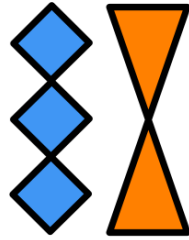
Things that will be the same.






	I will still have PE twice a week.

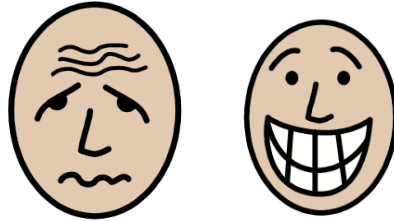
Things that will be different.

It is ok to ask questions.

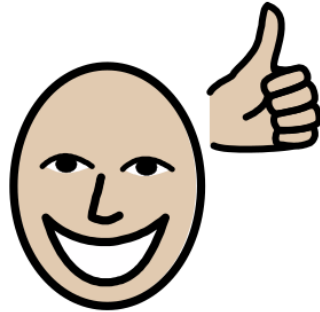


It is ok to not know what to do all the time.
