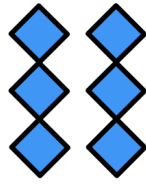
This is where my locker will be. It will be in the classroom. I can keep my bag and coat in there.










This is my classroom. It is one of the pods.

Things that will be the same.



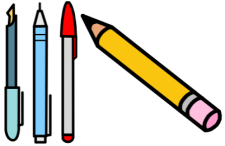
	I will need to bring my reading book and coat to school every day.

	Break times and lunch times are at the same times as this year.



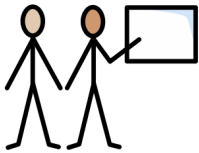
I will see all of my friends at break time and lunchtime.



I will still eat my lunch in the hall.



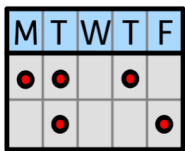
I will be given all of the equipment I need for each day so I still do not need to bring any pens or pencils into school.



I will still see my old teachers.



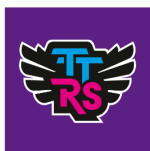
I will have PE twice a week.



There will still be a timetable on the board which will tell me what I am doing each day.

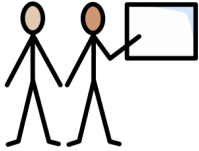
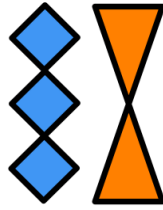


I will still get Maths and English homework and spellings to learn.

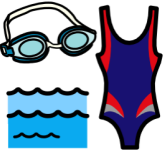


I will still need to practise on Times Tables Rock Stars.

My classroom is in a different part of the school.

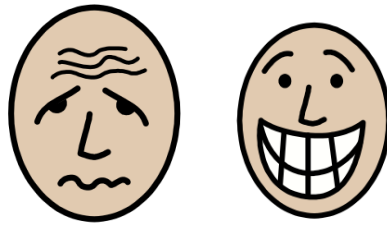


My locker is inside the classroom.

Everyone feels nervous and maybe excited when they are starting something new.



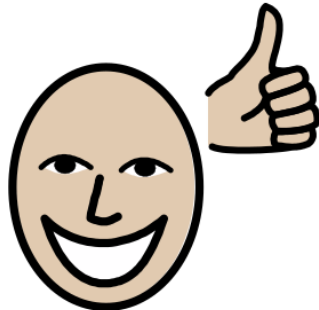
It is ok to ask questions.
