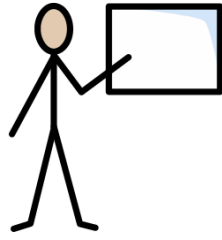
In September our Head Teacher will still be Mr Stace.

This is my classroom

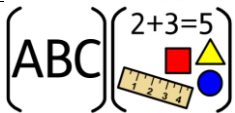
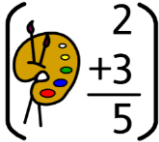
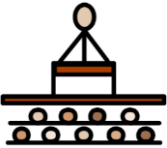
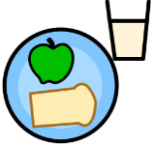


I will enter through the outside door. This will also be where I leave for break time and at the end of the day.



Things that will be the **same**.

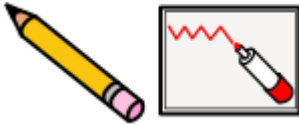
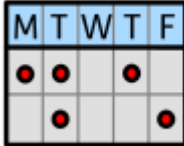


	I will need to bring my reading book, coat and water bottle every day.

	I will eat my lunch in the hall.

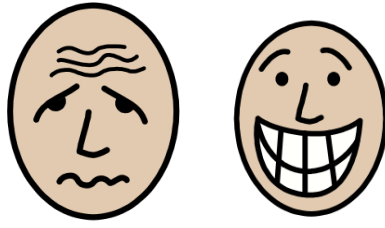
More things that will be the

It is ok to ask questions.

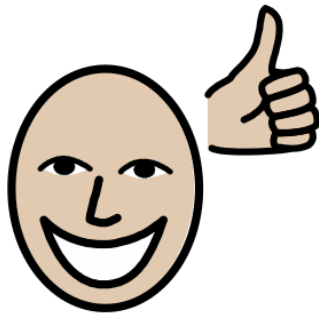


It is ok to not know what to do all the time.
