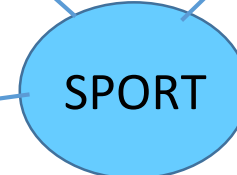




HOW WE SPEND THE SCHOOL SPORT FUND (£19,610) at BORINGDON PRIMARY SCHOOL 2020/21



The engagement of all pupils in regular physical – kick-starting healthy active lifestyle.

- Provision of a Specialist PE teacher to work alongside staff and children to develop expertise
